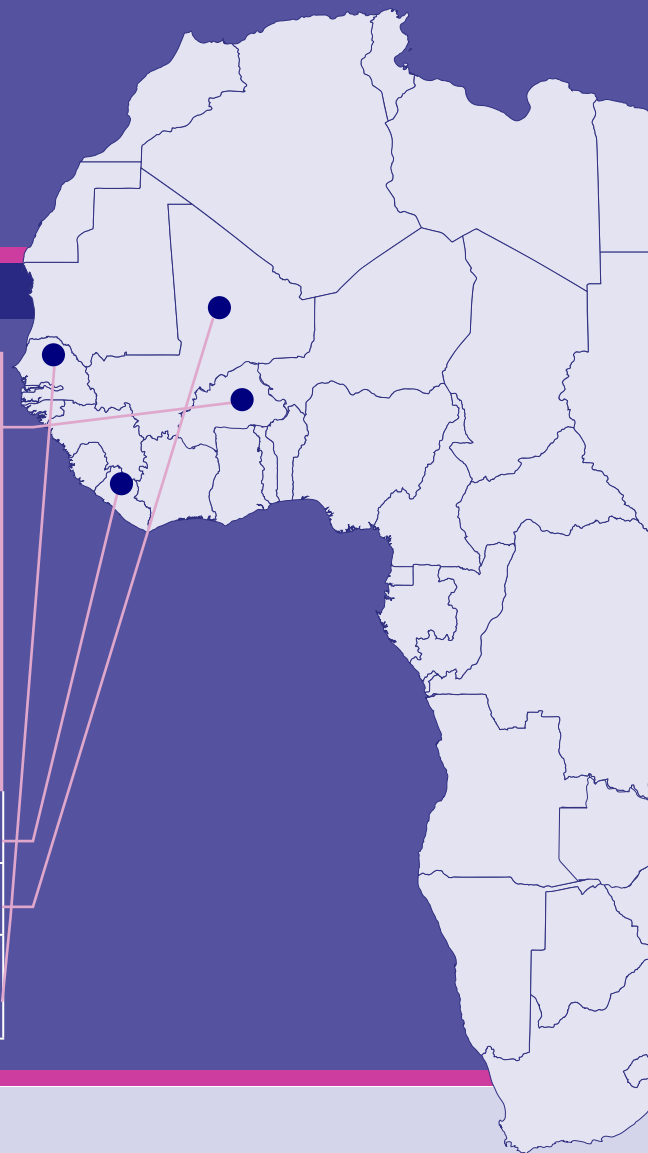
The table below details the results of completed ICF projects:

- Economic growth has exposed capacity constraints; sharing of knowledge and best practices is now a priority for almost all governments.

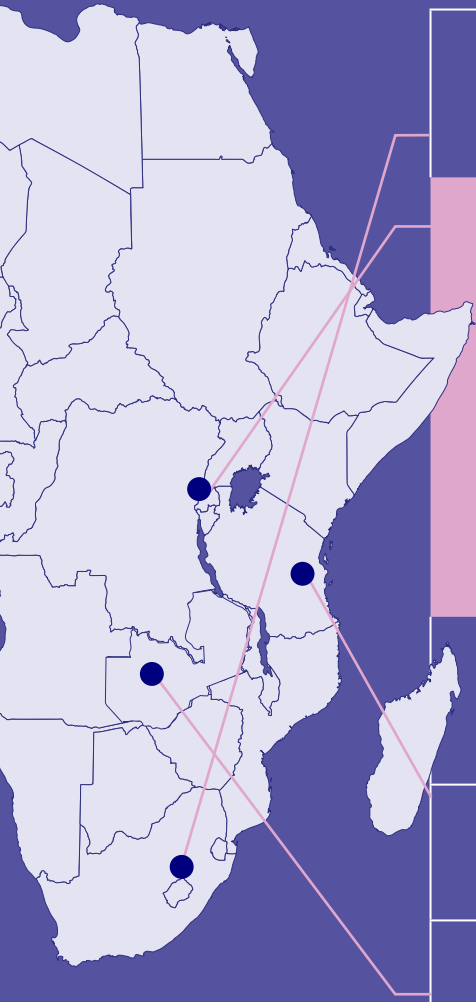
